Flush drains with a bucket of warm, soapy water

Dispose of any old or out-of-date stock

Empty bins if they have been unattended for more than a week

### COMMON PEST ACTIVITY

Rodent droppings are found in quiet, dark corners and on shelves

Cockroaches are found in decorative planters, under benches and dining tables.

Examine stored products for pest damage (gnawed holes or spilled contents)

Flies are found around ceiling and wall joints, hanging electrical cords, and around bins and drains
